FOOD MOTH TRAPS





CHASES AWAY FOOD MOTH

flour moths, cocoa

moths and dried fruit moths, cereals moths

Moths stick to the adhesive surface of the trap. Once the presence of moths has been observed, it is essential to check the premises (cupboards and elsewhere), then to carry out a good cleaning to eliminate eggs, larvae and pupae, and destroy soiled foodstuffs.

- To use indoors : the kitchen, living room and food storage areas
- Glue traps, moths stick to the adhesive surface of the trap.

INSTRUCTIONS OF USE

The trap should be used indoors, secured in a room or closet where food or pet food is stored.

1 - Remove the protective cover from the adhesive on the back of the trap and stick it in the desired location (inside a cupboard door for example).

2 - Remove the protective cover from the sticky surface. The trap is then operational.

3 - The trap must be renewed at the latest after 6 weeks or as soon as it is covered with moths.

INFESTED FOODS :

Day or night, if you often see small butterflies flying in the kitchen, living room, it's food moths. Each moth lays about 200 eggs. For 3 weeks, the larvae or caterpillars devour rice, pasta, tea, dried fruits (walnuts, hazelnuts, figs, almonds, prunes, raisins, pistachios, etc.), breakfast cereals, chocolate, dries vegetables (lentils, beans...), candies... After pupation, butterflies are born which reproduce again, this throughout the year.

IMPORTANT

Once the presence of moths is noted, it is essential to control the places (cupboards and elsewhere), then carry out a good cleaning to eliminate eggs, larvae and pupae, It is absolutely necessary to destroy food soiled.

ELEMINATION

Eliminate traps in the household trash.
