To obtain best performances, store this product under normal condition of 21°C and 50% relative humidity in the original packaging and use it within one year from date of purchase.

Application

- Remove dust and grease from the surface that leaks.
- Pull out 5 to 10 cm of tape. Begin wrapping the tape completely over itself 5 to 7 cm before the repair.
- Continue to stretch and wrap using a 1 cm overlap.
- When the desired wrap is achieved, pull out 5 to 10 cm of tape.
- Wrap the final piece of tape completely over itself.

Warning

This is not an adhesive tape.

Do not use on flues, chimneys, mufflers or tailpipes.

Tightness is not guaranteed under high water pressure.
