Manufactured by Laica in Italy conforms with overall migration limit:

- Overall migration is below 10 mg/dm² under standard testing conditions laid down in regulation EC 10/2011. Additional information can be provided on request.

The filter is intended to be in contact with:

- Any conditions of contact with WATER Any long-term storage at room temperature or below, including when packaged under hot-fill conditions, and/or heating up to a temperature T where $70\text{ °C} \leq T \leq 100\text{ °C}$ for a maximum of $t = 120/2^{(T-70)/10}$ minutes.

The filter was tested using simulants (defined in Annex III, Table 1, Reg. (EU) No. 10/2011) and test conditions (defined in Annex V, Table 3, Reg. (EU) No. 10/2011) presented below:

- Food simulant: Water
- Test conditions: 10 days at 40°C

The filter is made of:

- PP (Polypropylene)




